



MATH1030 CALCULUS A

This is a unit for students intending to study Engineering or certain disciplines in Science that require a high level of calculus, but have not passed TEE Calculus. It runs in the Summer Semester as an intensive course from Monday 21 January to Monday 18 February 2008, excluding weekends.

Classes will commence at 8:45 a.m. every day.

Lectures will be held in Engineering Lecture Theatre 1

There is no assigned textbook

This unit demands substantial contributions of time and effort from students. It requires almost full-time attendance during the day, with assigned homework and frequent tests. This means that it cannot realistically be done by a student who has a part-time job that makes demands on their time.

The content of the unit will be approximately the material which is in the TEE Calculus syllabus plus some parts of the Year 11 Geometry and Trigonometry syllabus.
